

Application for exemption from tuition fees for the second semester of FY2023

Applications for exemption from tuition fees for the second semester of FY2023 will be accepted as detailed below. Students who wish to apply for exemption are requested to read the details carefully and follow the required procedures. (Applications can only be accepted if each procedure is carried out within the specified time frame.)

1. Criteria of eligibility (Detailed selection criteria are available on the website (Japanese only).)

(1) Students who cannot afford to pay and are recognized as academically outstanding

However, students who have exceeded the prescribed term of study or who are repeating a year without special reason are not eligible to apply. If there is a special reason, it is necessary to submit a “supplementary form” in addition to the regular application documents. Students in this category should obtain the “supplementary form” and notes from the university office and check the exact criteria.

(2) Students in a situation since April 2023 where the person paying their fees has died, or the person paying fees or student himself/herself has suffered directly from a natural disaster or similar event, resulting in a situation where it would be extremely difficult to pay fees.

2. Procedures

Confirmation of results	Late December to early January	Notification of the decision regarding your application will be provided via your supervisor.
Payment of tuition fees	Late January	Students who were not granted exemption of fees, or who received a 50% exemption, should pay tuition fees in late January
