International graduate school students who would like to apply for tuition exemption need to take the following steps.

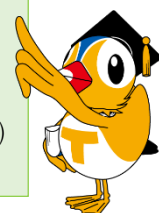
- ※This application is for privately-financed international students.

- ※If the application is incomplete or not submitted on the scheduled dates, it will not be accepted.

*The results of tuition exemption will be notified via the Academic Affairs Support System around late December or early January.

*If the result of tuition exemption is not approved or half of the tuition exemption, payment will be made in late January.
